



KLANG VALLEY JUNIOR GOLF CIRCUIT 2009

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

1. MANAGEMENT

The Klang Valley Junior Golf Circuit (KVJGC) shall be managed by a Tournament Committee appointed by Kelab Golf Negara Subang who reserved the right to make any changes or modification and whose decision on all matters shall be final.

2. VENUE & DATE

The second leg of the Tournament shall be played over the **MAIN COURSE (Hill Nine & Lake Nine)** of Kelab Golf Perkhidmatan Awam Malaysia, Bukit Kiara, Off Jalan Damansara, Kuala Lumpur on Sunday Afternoon 5th July 2009.

3. FORMAT OF PLAY

3.1. Individual Event – 1st Leg, 2nd Leg, 3rd Leg & Grand Final

The Tournament shall be decided by stroke play over 18 holes, subject to the Committee's right in the event of circumstances which make the playing of 18 holes impracticable, to cancel the round at its discretion.

3.2. Club Team Gross Event

A team event will be held in conjunction with the tournament. Points will be awarded to individuals from each Club in each category. The higher points collected by player from each category of each club will be count. Accumulated points of each club after 4 circuits will determine the Club Team Champion. Points gained per leg need not be from the same Individual.

In the event of a tie, the placing shall be decided on the awarded points in the following order:

- Grand Final Accumulated Points
- 3rd Leg Accumulated Points
- 2nd Leg Accumulated Points
- 1st Leg Accumulated Points

If such a procedure still does not produce a decision, the placing shall be decided by lot.

4. ELIGIBILITY

- 4.1 The tournament is open to male and female junior players below 19 years as at 31st December 2009 of which they are;
- a. A member of the junior development program of clubs in Klang Valley i.e. Kuala Lumpur & Selangor.
- 4.2. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to reject any entry without giving any reason whatsoever.

5. ENTRIES AND CLOSING DATE

- 5.1. The Entrance Fee for each competitor is RM 40.00 inclusive of green fee, goodies, prizes, lunch and hi-tea.
- 5.2. All entries are to be made on the Official Entry Form duly certified by the Club Captain or Secretary of which the competitor is a member and **MUST** reach the Tournament Office by 4:00 pm (16:00 hrs) on the 27th June 2009.
- 5.3. The completed **entry form MUST be accompanied with full entry fee** payable by cash, cheque or money order made payable to "KELAB GOLF NEGARA SUBANG".
- 5.4. Numbers of participants are limited to 120 competitors on first come first serve basis.
- 5.5. All competitors must have their own valid insurance.

6. WITHDRAWAL

- 6.1. Withdrawal from the Tournament will not be accepted and the Entry Fee will not be refunded if withdrawal is made after 4:00 pm on the 27th June 2009.
- 6.2. Competitors who have registered and did not turn up on the tournament day will be disqualified and classified as a **NO SHOW**. A no show means the competitor will not be allowed to participate in the future tournament.

7. CATEGORIES & PRIZES

- 7.1. A competitor is only eligible to win one prize only either gross or nett score. Gross score will take precedence over net score.
- 7.2. Prizes will be awarded according to categories as follows: -
- i. Individual Event – 1st Leg, 2nd Leg, 3rd & Grand Final

13. **DRAWS AND STARTING TIMES**

- 13.1. Play shall be in groups of four. The draws and starting times will be made by the Tournament Committee according to the competitor age group and handicap. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to vary the starting times at its absolute discretion.
- 13.2. The draws and starting times will be posted on the Tournament Notice Board at the Club House. Such posting will be considered sufficient enough notice for information and distribution.
- 13.3. The competitor shall start at the time laid down by the Tournament Committee. (Rule 6-3a). In the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if a competitor arrives at his/her starting point ready to play within five minutes after his/her starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time shall be two strokes at the starting hole instead of disqualification.

Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is disqualification.

- 13.4. Competitors are expected to announce his/her arrival to the Official Starter at their designated teeing ground at least ten (10) minutes before their starting time.

14. **PACE OF PLAY**

- 14.1. The attention of all competitors is drawn to Rule 6-7, the competitor shall play without undue delay. In the interest of fair play the Tournament Committee will not hesitate to impose the penalties provided by that Rule. The maximum time allotted for the completion of 18 holes is to be determined by the Tournament Committee. (Please see the Tournament Notice Board).
- 14.2. The following conditions shall apply under Rule 33-1. If a group is observed to be out of position, i.e. it has lost substantially more than its starting interval or in the case of the first flight has taken in the opinion of the Rules Official / Chief Referee / Tournament Director; an unacceptable amount of time to play any part of the golf course, the following action will be taken.
 - i. The group is liable to be timed without warning. (Individual clocking)
 - ii. From the commencement of any timing, if any player exceeds 50 seconds on a "first to play shot" or 40 seconds if it is a "second or third to play shot" he shall be deemed to have had a "bad time".

Penalty for breach of conditions:

- a. One bad time - Warning from official and told that if he/she has a further bad time he/she will be penalized
- b. Two bad times - One stroke penalty
- c. Three bad times - Further penalty of two strokes
- d. Four bad times - Disqualification.

A player whose group is timed will have a bad time carried forward in the round even if the group subsequently arrives back in position or within time as may be specified by the Rules Official / Chief Referee / Tournament Director.

15. CADDIE & BUGGY (*Caddie or buggy fees are to be made payable to the hosting club on the day of the event*)

15.1. The engagement of only one caddie at any one time is permissible to all age groups.

15.2. The competitor is responsible for any breach of the Rules by their caddie.

15.3. A competitor may engage any person other than a registered KGPA caddie to assist him/her during stipulated round and **MUST** register the caddie with the Tournament Director/Secretary in advance.

Penalty for breach of Rule: Two strokes penalty for each hole at which the breach occurred and four strokes maximum penalty per round.

15.4. A professional golfer may not be engaged as a caddie.

15.5. In circumstances that if the Hosting Club has limited number of caddies, usage of buggy will be allowed. The usage of buggy & caddie will be on sharing basis. (Please refer to Rule 17 of Conditions of Competition)

15.6. The competitors are responsible for their own caddie & buggy fee payable to the hosting club.

Penalty for breach of Rule: Disqualification

16. APPROVED EQUIPMENTS

16.1. Golf Balls

The ball the player plays must be named on the current list of Conforming Golf Balls issued by the R&A Rules Ltd may be used.

16.2. Driver Heads

Any driver the player carries must have a clubhead, identified by model and loft, that is named on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by the R&A Rules Ltd may be used.

Exception: A driver with a clubhead that was manufactured prior to 1999 is exempt from this condition.

Penalty for breach of condition: Disqualification.

17. UNAUTHORIZED TRANSPORTATION

Competitors shall walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permitted to ride by the Tournament Committee. Use of any unauthorized transportation is prohibited.

Penalty: Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; Maximum penalty: Four strokes. In the event of a breach between the play of two holes, the penalty applies to the next hole.

18. PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

The KVJGC takes great pride in the quality of its players and host facilities involvement at each tournament. In order to continue making the KVJGC experience enjoyable and rewarding for everyone, the Tournament Committee requires all participants adhere to a set of guidelines known as the Code of Conduct. Its purpose is to help KVJGC participants grow and mature by understanding and accepting the consequences of their actions. The Code of Conduct is to be followed throughout the tournament.

Any of the following actions by KVJGC participants at any KVJGC event, non-KVJGC event or toward another KVJGC participant anywhere, constitutes a violation of the KVJGC Code of Conduct:

- 18.1. Unsportsmanlike conduct including abusive language, cheating, club throwing, disrespect to volunteers, officials, fellow competitors or abuse of golf course property.
- 18.2. Not adhering to the dress code and local rules of host golf course.
- 18.3. Use or association with drug or smoking.
- 18.4. Physical abuse, threat of physical abuse, verbal abuse, slander or libel towards other players, parents, host golf course staff or members, KVJGC staff or volunteers.
- 18.5. Players who have applied to participate in any event and wish to withdraw for any reason **MUST** notify the Tournament Office at 03-7876 0388 prior to the event. If withdrawal on the day of the event, please call the golf course you are assigned to play. Players who fail to follow this procedure will be listed as a **NO SHOW**. A no shows by a player may result in the player's entry for future events being rejected.

Note : Any other "Breaches of Etiquette" not listed above will be dealt with by the Tournament Committee on individual basis.

Penalty: Disqualification

19. PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

In order to continue making The Klang Valley Junior Golf Circuit enjoyable for everyone, the Tournament Committee requires all members and parents to adhere to a set of guidelines to be followed throughout the entire tournament.

The Tournament Committee expectations from Parents:

- 19.1. Keep your distance from your child while following him or her throughout his or her tournament rounds at least 50 yards.
- 19.2. Teeing grounds, fairways and greens are prohibited.
- 19.3. No advice is to be given to your child during his or her tournaments rounds.
- 19.4. Do not make noise, talking loudly or shouting to your child because in doing so will disturb other players. **(The Officials / Tournament Committee may escort you out of the course).**
- 19.5. Do not walk in the fairways during the tournament rounds. (In the rough or on buggy path only).
- 19.6. Only assist participants in finding lost balls. (Please move away once the ball has been found).

- 19.7. Allow KVJGC Rules Officials to administer rulings. You will be brought into a situation ONLY if the Rules Official asks you.
- 19.8. When on the course, turn off cell phones or turn ringers to the silent or the vibrate mode. Respect host facility's policy if cell phones are not allowed.
- 19.9. Adhere to host facility's dress code. Some facilities may not allow blue jeans, t-shirts, slippers etc.

20. CODE OF CONDUCT VIOLATION PENALTIES

Any Code of Conduct violation will result in a written letter to the player and his or her parent/guardian. The KVJGC Tournament Committee may assess any or all of the following penalties based on severity and frequency of the violation(s):

- 20.1. One-stroke penalty for each act of unsportsmanlike behavior on the golf course and violation of host club rules.
- 20.2. Second offence will result in immediate disqualification from the tournament at which the violation occurs.
- 20.3. Depending on the severity of the violation, a tournament disqualification may also result in disqualification from the next event(s) for which a player has been accepted.
- 20.4. The KVJGC reserves the right to suspend or revoke a player's for a major breach of the KVJGC Code of Conduct.
- 20.5. Violation of the KVJGC Code of Conduct may affect a player's eligibility for invitational's and post-season honors.

21. INDEMINITY/LIABILITIES

The Pioneer Clubs, The Sponsors, The Organizers, MGA or the Host Club will not be responsible for any loss, damage or harm, or any form of injuries that the participants and personal caddies of the tournament may suffer as a result of their participation in this tournament.

22. MARKER

- 22.1. A "MARKER" is one who is appointed by the Tournament Committee to record a competitor's score after each hole. He may be a fellow competitor. He is not a referee.
- 22.2. Caddie is not permitted to act as "MARKER"

23. SCORE CARD

Score card must be submitted as soon as possible on completion of a round and in any case not later than 10 minutes after the completion of his/her round. A score card is deemed to be submitted the moment the competitor leaves the scoring area.

24. RECORDING OF SCORE

On completion of each stipulated round, the player shall;

- 24.1. Check his/her score every hole for accuracy.

24.2. Settle any doubtful points with the Tournament Committee.

24.3. Make sure that his/her marker has signed his/her card.

24.5. Countersign his/her score card.

25. RULES & DECISIONS

25.1 If a referee has been appointed by the Tournament Committee, his/her decision is final (Rule 34-2).

25.2 In the absence of a referee, any dispute or doubtful point on the Rules shall be referred to the Tournament Committee whose decision shall be final (Rule 34-3).

26. DISPUTES AND DOUBTFUL POINTS

Any dispute or doubtful point on the Rules shall be referred to the Committee as soon as possible on competition of the round and in any case not later than 15 minutes after completing the round.

27. APPEALS

A penalty of disqualification may in exceptional cases be waived, modified or imposed by the Appeals Committee.

Note: An appeal has to be made in writing to the Tournament Committee / Tournament Director by the competitor not later than 30 minutes after the completion of his/her round.

28. INCLEMENT WEATHER AND SUSPENSION OF PLAY

The Tournament Committee will make every effort to complete an event in its entirety. However, the Tournament Committee reserves the right to suspend or abandon play as necessary if weather related circumstances require such action. In the unlikely event the course is unplayable and abandons play or other conditions warranting such action, the Tournament Committee then will decide the tournament and all competitors will be informed accordingly.

29. HI-TEA & PRIZE PRESENTATION

Hi-Tea and prize presentation will be immediately after the game. (Please see Tournament Notice Board for time and venue).
